# Marvelous Testimonies Manifesting as Heaven Comes to Texas Revival

We have seen an unusual move of God here at New Life Church in Corpus Christi, Texas.

We started out just planning on meeting four consecutive Wednesday nights in July, beginning July 11.

It was obvious from the start that God was up to something. The first Wednesday, we had over people 100 respond to an altar call for repentance and salvation. The second Wednesday, another 100-plus people came forward.

Due to the responses, we planned a baptism Wednesday, Aug. 8. That night, we had 10 baptisms. We then added three additional Wednesday nights. The following Wednesday, we didn't have any scheduled baptisms but saw 200 people respond—many actually running to the altar. We baptized 31 people that night! So far, more than 120 people have been baptized in the last two weeks. Last year, we only saw 238 baptisms.

The revival first started when senior pastor Mike Fehlauer developed a deep hunger to see more of God's presence as a response to the post-Christian society.

While the church normally holds a midweek service only the first Wednesday of each month, Fehlauer felt the Lord tell him that if we wanted more of God, we needed to give Him more, we needed to give Him the room to move. So we added each Wednesday night service to our calendar during the month of July.

It wasn't enough. We soon added Thursday and Friday night services.

Part of the revival involves Communion. We have several stations throughout the worship center and during worship people, on their own, are coming to the Communion tables and worshipping through Communion as a family, friends and so on.

Each service is livestreamed on Facebook. As a result, we're beginning to see other church leaders from our community come to the revival and tune in via livestream.

One of our members—completely unaware the staff has been praying for an awakening to take place—had an open vision of what we are now beginning to see.

Here's what Molly Shlumpberger shared:

Last night as I was falling asleep I was half-awake and half-asleep. I began to see the church, our church, and there were hundreds, if not thousands, of people at the door just waiting for the doors to be opened. It was not a Sunday service day. It was almost frightening, the behavior that people were displaying to just get in the door. Like clinging and pressing through, so desperate to get in. The people looked like something you would see on The Walking Dead, and they were literally piling on top of one another, smashed up against the glass waiting to get in.

No one was angry or evil or mean. They just looked that way, but they just wanted in the doors. Their clothes were torn and their skin was gray. I mean they looked just like a Walking Dead picture. Someone came up and had a ton of keys on a key chain and was fumbling around to open the doors. I asked the Lord at

that moment, "What am I seeing?" And He said, "I'm coming, revival is coming." At this point in my mind, I'm trying to figure out if I'm imagining this or if what I'm seeing is really real.

The inner vision continues to play out like a movie, and once the doors open, there are literally people lying everywhere from the doors throughout the entire church. In the atrium, worship center down the hallways. You had to step over people to walk anywhere.

Then the Lord said, "They just want to be in my presence." It was like people just knew coming there was going to fix whatever it was. No one spoke; it was just hundreds of bodies all over the place.

I laid in bed trying to figure out what I was experiencing. I prayed, and I spoke life and words calling people to the church. I cried, and I honestly still don't know what to call what I saw. My dreams are more parables, and the visions I had before were more me in the Spirit. This was like an inner vision movie because I was awake but I didn't have to figure any parable out. It was pretty straightforward.

It's pretty powerful. Keep in mind, she has no point of reference regarding what massive revivals look like, as she is a

# Dove Awards Honors Best in Contemporary Christian and Gospel Music

Tauren Wells, Zach Williams, Matthew West and MercyMe were among those honored at the 49th Annual GMA Dove Awards.

The 49th Annual GMA Dove Awards were celebrated on Tuesday, October 16, 2018 live from Allen Arena at Lipscomb University in Nashville, Tennessee. The show will be televised on Trinity Broadcasting Network (TBN) on Sunday, October 21st at 8 p.m. CT/9 p.m. ET.

First-time nominee, Tauren Wells took home four of his eight nominations. Wells was honored with four awards for Contemporary Christian Artist of the Year, New Artist of the Year, Rap/Hip Hop Recorded Song of the Year and Pop/Contemporary Album of the Year.

Wells, the former lead singer for Christian rock group Royal Tailor, performed his number-one single "Known" from his solo debut album, Hills and Valleys, and performed "War Cry" with Social Club Misfits.

"While it's great to pose for all these pictures and getting to hold all these trophies, this doesn't matter as much as what is happening inside our hearts," said Wells backstage.

As far as other wins, Zach Williams took home Artist of the Year; Reckless Love was named Song of the Year; Matthew West was honored as Songwriter of the Year and Inspirational Film of the Year was awarded to "I Can Only Imagine," among other awards.

The evening also included many outstanding performances, including first time collaborations with Kirk Franklin and Tori Kelly, Jason Crabb and Rascal Flatts, as well as Natalie Grant and Koryn Hawthorne.

## Let Go of the Dead Stuff in Your Life

Have you ever hired a professional to prune a tree in your yard? Dave and I hire someone to do that for us and there are times when he cuts the branches back so far that I've said to him, "There is nothing left. You have totally destroyed our tree!" But he says, "You just watch and see." And sure enough, before long the tree is much better looking than it was before.

Just like trees need pruning from time to time to remove dead branches or areas where there is overgrowth, you and I need to be pruned or reshaped at different times in different areas of our lives. We may not enjoy the pruning process, but when it's over, we're much better off than we were before.

You see, God wants us to be at our very best—spiritually, emotionally and physically.

John 15:2 (AMPC) says, "Any branch in Me that does not bear fruit [that stops bearing] He cuts away (trims off, takes away); and He cleanses and repeatedly prunes every branch that continues to bear fruit, to make it bear more and richer and more excellent fruit."

It's good for us to stop and evaluate our lives sometimes and ask God to show us if there are things that need to be cut off because they are hindering our growth in our relationship with Him. Ask yourself: Am I dragging around "dead branches" in my life? Maybe it's a bad relationship, an old wound from your past, or a negative attitude that keeps you from enjoying life to the fullest.

It would be nice if we could see what God sees and say, "Yes, God. Let's get rid of that dead branch." But many times we're too afraid to give up what we know for something new that we just can't see or understand.

The truth is you can be miserable dragging those dead things around or you can go through the pain of letting God "prune" them away. Even though it's uncomfortable, the best thing you can do is let God prune you, because after the hard part is over, you will see some amazing results!

God doesn't want to see you struggle. He loves you so much that He will never give up on you. As we allow Him to speak into our lives, He teaches and trains us to be kind and gentle, peaceful and patient,

loving and forgiving like Him. But we cannot develop that "fruit" on our own.

John 15:4 (AMPC) says, "Just as no branch can bear fruit of itself without abiding in (being vitally united to) the vine, neither can you bear fruit unless you abide in Me."

In other words, we need to spend time with God.

Our relationship with God is about much more than going to church on Sunday and reading the Word as a religious duty. He wants a personal relationship with each of us.

When we stay connected to God through meaningful Bible study and prayer, we're abiding in Jesus. God wants us to be so rooted and grounded in His love that nothing can shake us—so we're able to bear good fruit in even the hardest, most difficult seasons of life.

God has a good plan for your life. He wants to take you to the next level in your relationship with Him, but there are some things that He wants you to leave behind—past hurts, insecurities, or anything you look to for a sense of security other than God Himself.

Don't ever be afraid to surrender to God so He can prune the things that are hurting and hindering you from moving forward in your relationship with Him.

The apostle Paul said,  
"One thing I do [it is my

# Revival Comes to Rural America

Let us boldly proclaim and testify of what is happening all over the United States....great revival is beginning to sweep across this great nation, but the greatest move of Holy Spirit seems to be in rural America.

# My Answer

By Billy Graham

Q: I get upset at all the mail we get this time of year from charities and agencies asking for money. I just throw most of them in the trash. I know we could give more than we do, but how can I know who really needs money and will use it wisely?

A: Although you may not be aware of it, many nonprofit organizations (including our own) depend on year-end giving to balance their budgets and keep their work on a solid financial foundation. Without these gifts, their work would have to be cut back, and countless people who depend on them would be seriously affected.

This is why I hope you'll do at least two things as you consider your year-end giving. First, realize that your money isn't really yours. God gave it to you; He gave you the ability to earn it, and He gave you the opportunity to use it wisely. Perhaps this is a radical thought to you—but it should give you a sincere “attitude of gratitude” for all you have. The Bible says, “When God gives someone wealth and possessions … this is a gift of God” (Ecclesiastes 5:19). Second, pray about your giving. God knows what you can give—and He also knows where it will do the most good. No, you can't support every worthwhile project; the needs are too great. But ask God to guide you to organizations and projects you can support—especially ones that touch people's lives for Christ. Your pastor may be able to point you to groups that have a sound financial reputation. Don't, however, overlook your most important gift—and that is the gift of your life to Jesus Christ. He gave His life for us; why give anything less to Him?

Q: My five siblings and I never have been very close (in fact, to be honest we've never gotten along very well). Now out of the blue, one of our sisters has invited all of us and our families for Christmas dinner. How can we keep it from turning into another family fight?

A: Have you asked yourself why your sister is taking this step? Only she could answer this, of course—but I strongly suspect it's because she knows it's not good for your families to continue at odds with each other, and she wants to help overcome this. The Bible says, “Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!” (Psalm 133:1, NKJV).


Is this possible? Yes—if you and your families deliberately try to overcome your past disputes, God's help you can change the future—and I pray you will, both for your sakes and the sake of your children. 

# 10 More Signs that a Church has Settled for Mediocrity

By Chuck Lawless

Several years ago, I posted on —Signs of Mediocrity in a Church.<sup>11</sup> Today, I add to that list other signs I've seen as a church consultant:

1. They haven't tackled any "God- sized" task in years. That is, they're going through the motions, doing things as they've always done them—and they wouldn't know what to do if God did something not already planned in their weekly bulletin.

2. Prayer is perfunctory, not passionate and powerful. You can usually tell when that's the case, too. Folks pray, but they do it because that's what they're supposed to do—and it's usually only in response to something wrong.

3. They provide no training for workers. If you put workers in place but don't expect them to be trained (in fact, not even offer them any training), you can't expect them to improve much.

4. Nobody's asking about the lack of growth or baptisms. The church isn't reaching anybody, but nobody seems aware or concerned enough to ask, —Why?<sup>12</sup> Status quo is apparently acceptable.

5. They've come to be okay with "I really didn't have time to prepare this week. . . ." I realize churches almost expect some of their leaders to make this statement.

6. No small groups are reproducing themselves. That's often because the leaders and groups have grown comfortable with where they are. Nobody wants to move out, so everybody settles.

7. They have stopped challenging members to increase the sacrifice of their giving. Too many members never deepen their sacrifice because the church never lays that challenge before them. Whatever they gave years ago is still acceptable today.

8. They fight change just because it's change. They can't explain why they're opposed to the change; they just are—and nothing ever improves.

9. Excellence is apparently not the goal. Whether it's the preaching, the music, the facility, the programs, or whatever the church is doing, members seem to think they can do less than their best for the glory of God.

10. They tend to judge other churches. Churches living in mediocrity don't improve; they just make themselves feel better by tearing down other congregations.

What other signs have you seen?


